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STATUS OF FINANCIAL IMPLEMENTATION OF GOVERNING COUNCIL-APPROVED COUNTRY PROGRAMMES AND PROJECTS

Report of the Executive Director

SUMMARY

This report of the Executive Director on the status of financial implementation of Governing Council-approved UNFPA country programmes and projects is prepared in response to decision 84/21 III, paragraph 2, which was taken by the Governing Council at its thirty-first session. It contains details on expenditures to these programmes and projects by year as well as by region and country, showing the amounts still to be allocated under Governing Council approvals. It also assesses the level of programme implementation by applying the concept of the multi-year resource delivery rate as introduced in document DP/1989/34 submitted to the thirty-sixth session of the Council. This document is submitted to the Council for its information.

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I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. At its thirtieth session (1983), the Governing Council, in decision 83/17 I, paragraph 19, requested the Executive Director to submit to the Council a report on its programme and project approvals by country, giving the period covered, total commitments, expenditures of past years and current allocations. In compliance with this request, the Executive Director provided the required information to the Council at its thirty-first session, in a document entitled "Report of the Executive Director on the Status of Financial Implementation of Governing Council-Approved UNFPA Country Programmes and Projects" (DP/1984/32).
- 2. At its thirty-first session, the Council expressed its appreciation for the report provided by the Executive Director and requested, in decision 84/21 III, paragraph 2, that similar reports be provided in future years. The Executive Director herewith presents the ninth update of this information, which should be read in conjunction with the "Work Plan for 1994-1997 and Request for Programme Expenditure Authority" (DP/1993/30), also being submitted to the Governing Council at its fortieth session.
- 3. In view of the concern of the Council about the timeliness of allocations that are based upon Council approval, this report is structured according to the date of approval by the Council rather than according to geographical or other country groupings. Thus, information is provided on: (a) those programmes and projects that were completed in 1992 and those that were ongoing in January 1993; and (b) those that are being submitted to the fortieth session.
- 4. To give a more accurate picture of the progress of UNFPA activities, estimated expenditures for 1992 have been used rather than allocations for that year.
- 5. This report provides information on the "resource delivery rate" of programmes completed in 1992. The programme resource delivery rate, which was defined in document DP/1989/34, is expressed as the total expenditure for a programme divided by the total amount approved by the Governing Council for that programme. Tables include the resource delivery rate for each completed programme and the current expenditure rate for each ongoing programme. The current expenditure rate is the total expenditure accumulated up to and including 1992 divided by the total amount approved. It applies to ongoing programmes only. When a programme completes its cycle, the current expenditure rate becomes the resource delivery rate.
- 6. In terms of the format of tables, it is important to note the following: the starting date of a programme is the one approved by the Governing Council; the end of a programme is either (a) the year when all projects were completed, or (b) the year when a subsequent programme began. There cannot be two contemporaneous UNFPA programmes within one country. For programmes starting and/or ending in the middle of a year, the yearly expenditures have been prorated.
- 7. In compliance with the Governing Council request, and because UNFPA has sought and obtained assistance from multi-bilateral sources to supplement its regular budget, the presentation of the data reflects these additional contributions. Tables A.1 to A.8 show the expenditures for country programmes approved by the Governing Council, year by year.

- 8. In these tables, the priority status of countries reflects the status prevailing in the year of approval. The total amount of funds approved by the Governing Council is shown in column (1). This amount is composed of funds programmed from UNFPA regular resources and funds from other resources. The latter are a combination of additional UNFPA regular resources (beyond the programmed regular resources) and other resources, including multi-bilateral resources. Column (2) shows the amount of regular funds programmed. Column (3) shows all funds spent for 1992 (and therefore includes the expenditures of regular funds and of other resources, including multi-bilateral funds). Column (4) shows all regular funds spent for 1992. Column (5) shows all funds spent for all years. Column (6) shows all regular funds spent for all years.
- 9. The resource delivery rates of completed programmes and the current rates of expenditure of ongoing programmes appear in column (7) of tables A.1 to A.8. The calculations of the rates take into account all funds. Column (8) of the tables for completed programmes shows the balance between the amount of regular funds that have been programmed, and thus constituted UNFPA commitments, and the amount of regular funds that have been expended. Such balances, if any, are subsumed in the amounts of the following country programmes. It should be noted that when the balance of commitments in column (8) is negative it is recorded as zero. In the case of ongoing programmes, column (8) shows the amount of regular funds that have been programmed but not yet spent and thus reflects the balance of UNFPA commitments to the specific countries in question. It also should be noted that "regular funds" spent (column (6)) exceeding "programmed regular funds" (column (2)) does not necessarily indicate an over-expenditure, since UNFPA is authorized by the Council to use regular funds to make up the difference between the amount of funds programmed from regular resources and the total amount approved for the programme. Column (9) shows the rate of all regular funds spent for all years to the amount of regular funds programmed. Table B lists the new submissions to the fortieth session of the Council. The total balance of UNFPA commitments to country programmes is reflected in table C, which also shows breakdown by region.

II. COUNTRY PROGRAMMES APPROVED BY THE COUNCIL AT ITS THIRTY-SECOND THROUGH THIRTY-NINTH SESSIONS

- 10. At its thirty-second session in 1985 (table A.1), the Governing Council approved eight country programmes and two projects. Of these, nine were completed prior to 1992 and the last one, Sierra Leone, ended in 1992. Expenditures for the programme in Sierra Leone are contained in table A.1. A new programme for this country is being submitted for approval to the fortieth session of the Governing Council (table B).
- 11. At its thirty-third session in 1986 (table A.2), the Governing Council approved seven country programmes. Of these, five were completed prior to 1992 and two, Pakistan and Zaire, are ongoing. Expenditures for the ongoing programmes are contained in table A.2.

- 12. At its thirty-fourth session (1987), the Governing Council approved 31 country programmes. Of these, 23 were completed prior to 1992 and six in 1992, while two, Liberia and Somalia, are ongoing. Expenditures for the programmes completed in 1992 and for the ongoing programmes are contained in table A.3. UNFPA has developed new programmes for all six countries that completed their programmes in 1992. The programme for Burundi was approved in 1992 and began in January 1993. New programmes for Ethiopia, Guinea-Bissau, Madagascar, Mali and Rwanda are being submitted for approval by the Council at its fortieth session (table B).
- 13. At its thirty-fifth session (1988), the Governing Council approved 16 country programmes. Of these, seven were completed prior to 1992 and five in 1992, while four, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Turkey and Zambia, are ongoing. Expenditures for the programmes completed in 1992 and for the ongoing programmes are contained in table A.4. For the countries that completed their programmes in 1992, Bhutan and Nepal have new programmes that began in July 1992 and Paraguay has one that began in January 1993, while for the other two countries, Colombia and Uganda, new programmes are being submitted for approval to the Governing Council at its fortieth session and are shown in table B.
- 14. At its thirty-sixth session (1989), the Governing Council approved 13 country programmes. Of these, two, the Central African Republic and Sao Tome and Principe, were completed in 1992 and new programmes for these two countries are being submitted for approval to the fortieth session of the Governing Council. The other 11 programmes are ongoing. Expenditures for the completed as well as for the ongoing programmes are contained in table A.5.
- 15. At its thirty-seventh session (1990), the Governing Council approved 13 country programmes. Of these, two, the Cote d'Ivoire and Equatorial Guinea, were completed in 1992 and new programmes for these two countries are being submitted for approval to the fortieth session of the Governing Council. The other 11 programmes are ongoing. Expenditures for the completed as well as for the ongoing programmes are contained in table A.6.
- 16. At its thirty-eighth session (1991), the Governing Council approved 14 country programmes as well as a subregional programme for the English-speaking Caribbean. Expenditures for these programmes, which are all ongoing, are contained in table A.7.
- 17. At its thirty-ninth session (1992), the Governing Council approved 30 country programmes as well as a subregional programme for the South Pacific. Expenditures for these programmes, which are all ongoing, are contained in table A.8.

III. SUBMISSIONS OF PROPOSED COUNTRY PROGRAMMES TO THE COUNCIL AT ITS FORTIETH SESSION

18. UNFPA is submitting to the fortieth session of the Council for its consideration and approval 15 country programmes (11 in sub-Saharan Africa, two in Asia and the Pacific, and two in Latin America and the Caribbean) which are presented in table B. The total amount for these programmes is \$118.5 million, of which \$77.7 million are programmed from regular funds and \$40.8 million are to be sought from other resources including multi-bilateral resources.
