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## UNITED NATIONS POPULATION FUND

Annual financial review, 1992

### Summary

In this report, the Executive Director provides, as requested by the Governing Council, a financial review of the activities financed by UNFPA and of its trust funds in 1992. The report shows the Fund's financial position and accounts as at the end of 1992. Annual data on income and expenditures are included for 1990, 1991 and 1992. The annexes include the unaudited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 1992.

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### Introduction

- 1. In response to decisions 85/20 and 87/31, paragraph 9, adopted by the Governing Council at its thirty-second and thirty-fourth sessions, respectively, the Executive Director presents in this report a review of the financial situation of the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) for 1992. As in prior years, the information and financial data available for the preparation of this report include the unaudited financial statements of the Fund (Annexes I and II). Data presented in this report reflect the financial status of UNFPA during the first year of the biennium of 1992-1993.
- 2. This document includes the actual data available for 1990 and 1991. Audited data for these years were extracted from the UNFPA year-end audited financial statements as contained in document A/47/5/Add.7. For the reasons noted in that document, the United Nations Board of Auditors qualified its audit opinion on the financial statements of UNFPA for the biennium ended 31 December 1991. A detailed progress report on steps taken to implement recommendations of the Board of Auditors is being submitted to this session of the Governing Council in document DP/1993/37.
- 3. The 1992 figures provided herein include data obtained from the unaudited annual accounts of the executing agencies with regard to the status of funds allocated to them and expended in the execution of UNFPA projects during 1992. Should any changes be reported in the audited accounts of any of the executing agencies for the biennium 1992-1993, they will be reported by the Executive Director to the Governing Council at its forty-second session in the audited statements and audit reports.
- 4. A financial summary containing information on budgetary trends is provided in Annex IX. These data are provided as requested by the Governing Council at its thirty-second and thirty-fourth sessions.

#### I. ANNUAL REVIEW OF THE FUND'S FINANCIAL SITUATION

# A. Income and expenditure

5. Table 1 provides a summary of 1992 pledges and payments by donors as compared to 1990 and 1991. Annex III shows in detail the status of the voluntary contributions pledged by all donors as at 31 December 1992. After writing off as uncollectable prior years' pledges amounting to \$276,447, the outstanding cumulative balance of unpaid pledges as at 31 December 1992 was \$1.9 million, as follows:

- 6. Table 2 shows a comparison of income and expenditures for 1990, 1991 and 1992. Total income in 1992 amounted to \$238.2 million and total expenditures to \$193.6 million. This resulted in an excess of income over expenditure of \$44.6 million. Annual income includes pledges from Governments, investment income and miscellaneous income but excludes contributions to trust funds. In accordance with UNFPA Financial Rule 116.1(a), income was recorded on an accrual basis. As required by Financial Rule 104.1, all pledges were recorded in United States dollars, converted at the United Nations operational rate of exchange in effect on the date of the pledge and, if paid, converted at the rate of exchange prevailing on the date of the payment.
- 7. Total income in 1992 increased by \$14.2 million or 6.3 per cent over the 1991 income of \$224.0 million and by \$25.8 million or 12.1 per cent over the 1990 income of \$212.4 million. Total contributions pledged by 105 Governments in 1992 reached \$233.8 million, an increase of \$13.1 million in dollar terms or 5.9 per cent over the \$220.7 million pledged in 1991. Interest income amounted to \$3.1 million or 1.3 per cent of total income. Other miscellaneous income and adjustments, including revaluation of currencies and gains/losses on currency exchange, totalled \$1.3 million (table 2). The 6.3 per cent increase in income in 1992 was, in large part, the result of gains from favourable exchange rates, as payments in currencies other than the US dollar accounted for the majority of the contributions to UNFPA.

# B. Programme expenditures

As shown in table 2, total expenditures in 1992 were \$193.6 million, a decrease of \$35.5 million or 15.5 per cent compared to 1991 expenditures and a decrease of \$27.7 million or 12.5 per cent compared to 1990 expenditures. Table 3 compares programme expenditures and administrative and programme support services (APSS) budget expenditures for 1990, 1991 and 1992 as a percentage of total expenditures. Under the successor support-cost arrangements (approved by the Council in decision 91/37, para. 10), beginning in 1992 all technical support services (TSS) costs and administrative and operational services (AOS) costs are included under programme expenditures. Thus, the concept of operational costs, as previously defined in the UNFPA work plan, as comprising agency support costs and the APSS budget, is no longer used by UNFPA. TSS and AOS costs include technical and administrative support services to country projects provided by executing agencies. Under the support-cost arrangements prior to 1992, United Nations executing agencies were reimbursed support costs at the rate of 13 per cent of the total project expenditure executed by the agency, and some of the costs of technical advisers covered under the new TSS arrangements were financed from intercountry programmes. Under the new successor support-cost arrangement, UNFPA reimburses United Nations executing agencies for AOS costs at the rate of 7.5 per cent of country project expenditures executed by agencies. Programme expenditures in 1992, which amounted to \$151.0 million, constituted 78.0 per cent of the total expenditures, compared to 81.5 per cent in 1991 and 82.9 per cent in 1990. The APSS expenditure in 1992, comprising the headquarters administrative budget and total field office costs, amounted to \$42.6 million or 22.0 per cent of total expenditures compared to \$42.3 million or 18.5 per cent of total expenditures in 1991 and \$37.8 million or 17.1 per cent of total expenditures in 1990.

- 9. The APSS field office expenditure in 1992 totalled \$18.8 million. This compares to all field office costs of \$18.7 million in 1991 and \$15.6 million in 1990. TSS costs in 1992 were \$14.5 million and AOS costs were \$8.3 million, for a total of \$22.8 million, or 11.8 per cent of total expenditure. Agency support costs were \$15.0 million or 6.5 per cent of total expenditure in 1991 and \$14.6 million or 6.6 per cent of total expenditure in 1990. For the reasons mentioned above, these amounts are not directly comparable to TSS and AOS expenditures in 1992. In 1992, AOS costs were composed of the reimbursement to United Nations executing agencies for support services to country projects (\$4.9 million), payment of overhead charges to non-governmental organizations (NGOs) (\$1.0 million), reimbursement to UNFPA derived from procurement services provided to government-executed projects (\$1.1 million) and overhead charges assessed to government-executed projects (\$1.3 million).
- 10. As shown in table 4, in 1992 the United Nations executing agencies, including the regional commissions, executed projects amounting to \$50.1 million compared to \$91.4 million in 1991 and \$90.5 million in 1990. Governments, with the assistance of UNFPA field offices, executed \$27.5 million in 1992, compared to \$30.9 million in 1991 and \$33.3 million in 1990. Expenditures for government-executed projects did not include \$4.1 million of advances to Governments, which at year-end were held by Governments and not reported as expenditure (see also Annex II). UNFPA-executed projects totalled \$31.2 million in 1992, compared to \$29.5 million in 1991 and \$25.6 million in 1990, and included procurement assistance in respect of government projects amounting to \$21.8 million in 1992, \$13.4 million in 1991, and \$15.5 million in 1990. Programme expenditures for projects executed by NGOs and other agencies, such as intergovernmental institutions and academic and research centres, were \$19.4 million in 1992, compared to \$20.0 million in 1991 and \$19.5 million in 1990. Expenditures for NGO-executed projects in 1992 did not include \$4.4 million of advances to NGOs, which at year-end were held by these institutions (see also Annex II).
- 11. Table 4 also shows the percentage breakdown of project expenditures by executing agency for 1990, 1991 and 1992. Projects executed by the United Nations and its specialized agencies and regional commissions amounted to \$50.1 million or 39.1 per cent of project expenditures of \$128.2 million in 1992. Governments executed \$27.5 million or 21.5 per cent of project expenditures in 1992. NGOs and other agencies, including intergovernmental institutions, executed \$19.4 million or 15.1 per cent of project expenditures in 1992. Annex IV shows 1992 programme expenditures (including TSS and AOS costs) by executing agency and by major expenditure component of the project budgets. Annex VII shows project expenditures by country for 1990, 1991 and 1992.

# C. Status of unexpended balance of general resources

12. On 1 January 1992, the balance of available funds for programming showed a deficit of \$5.5 million. As shown in table 5, after adding an excess of income over expenditure of \$44.6 million, and transferring \$3.0 million to the operational reserve and \$2.5 million to the reserve for field accommodation, the unexpended balance of general resources available for programming was \$33.6 million as at 31 December 1992 (see also Annex II).

# D. Status of the operational reserve and the reserve for field accommodation

- 13. The operational reserve was established by the Governing Council in January 1973 at the \$20 million level to guarantee the financial viability and integrity of the UNFPA programme. In accordance with Governing Council decision 89/49, paragraph 16, during 1992 UNFPA maintained a fully funded operational reserve at the level of \$45.0 million (see Annex II). At its thirty-eighth session, the Governing Council in decision 91/36 decided that the level of the operational reserve should be set at 20 per cent of general resources income for each year of the UNFPA work plan, and that it would review the level of the reserve every other year. Consequently, in order to maintain that proportion, in 1992, UNFPA transferred \$3.0 million to the operational reserve, which now stands at \$48.0 million.
- 14. The Council, at its thirty-eighth session (1991) approved, in decision 91/36, paragraph 17, the establishment of a reserve for field accommodation at the level of \$5 million for the biennium 1992-1993 and authorized the Executive Director to make drawdowns from it for the purpose of financing the UNFPA share of construction costs of common premises under the auspices of the Joint Consultative Group on Policy. In line with this decision, \$2.5 million was transferred from unspent resources to this reserve in 1992.

# E. Liquidity position

15. Table 6 shows the Fund's gross liquid assets as at 31 December 1992, as compared to 1990 and 1991. As at 31 December 1992, UNFPA had bank balances in convertible currencies and time-deposit investments amounting to \$121.2 million, which included \$48.0 million of time-deposit investments of the operational reserve, \$2.5 million in the reserve for field accommodation and \$11.0 million belonging to UNFPA trust funds (see Annexes II and V). The investments reported in table 6 and in Annex II were recorded using the United Nations operational rate of exchange that came into effect on 1 December 1992. At the United Nations operational rate of exchange in effect from 1 January 1993, which more closely reflected the market rate of exchange as at 31 December 1992, the value of these investments would amount to \$103,449 less than that shown in the accounts.

### F. Special population programmes

16. As authorized by the Governing Council at its seventeenth session (decision 74/16, paragraph (e)), UNFPA received cash remittances totalling \$19.7 million in 1992 from the Governments of Japan, the Netherlands and Norway to be transferred by UNFPA to designated special population programmes. The four recipients of these funds were the International Planned Parenthood Federation (\$19.1 million, from Japan and the Netherlands), The Population Council (\$0.3 million, from the Netherlands and Norway), the International Union for the Scientific Study of Population (\$0.2 million, from the Netherlands and Norway) and the International Council on Management of Population Programmes (\$0.1 million from Norway).

# II. UNFPA TRUST FUNDS

17. Table 7 shows that in 1992 total income (contributions plus interest income) from donors for multi-bilateral-funded projects and activities under funds-in-trust arrangements was

the equivalent of \$13.1 million, showing an increase of \$4.2 million (47.2 per cent) compared to \$8.9 million received in 1991 for multi-bilateral-funded projects. In addition, UNFPA received in 1992 \$30.1 million for contraceptive procurement services to a project of the Government of Bangladesh, comprising \$13.4 million from the World Bank and \$16.7 million from Kreditanstalt Fur Wiederaufbau (KFW) of the Federal Republic of Germany. As at 1 January 1992, the unexpended balance of the trust funds was \$7.6 million, which when added to the total income of \$43.1 million received under funds-in-trust agreements in 1992, resulted in a total amount available for programming in 1992 of \$50.7 million. Total expenditures were \$39.8 million in 1992 compared to \$11.5 million in 1991, largely due to the significant increase in procurement assistance provided under this modality. Transfers back to donor Governments in respect of completed projects totalled \$0.1 million, leaving an unexpended balance as at 31 December 1992 of \$11.0 million, which is available to finance trust fund activities in 1993. Annex V shows the statement of accounts as at 31 December 1992 for 26 trust funds managed by UNFPA in 1992, while Annex VI reflects the status of collections and unpaid pledges as at 31 December 1992.

In 1992, TSS expenditures were \$14.5 million and AOS expenditures were \$8.3 million.

The level of the operational reserve was reviewed at the thirty-eighth session (1991) of the Governing Council, which decided in decision 91/36 to set the operational reserve at 20 per cent of the general resources income in the work plan for each year. Accordingly, during 1992, the level of the operational reserve was increased by \$3.0 million.
- The Council, at its thirty-eighth session (1991), approved in decision 91/36, paragraph 17, the establishment of a reserve for field accommodation at the level of \$5 million for the biennium 1992-1993 and authorized the Executive Director to make drawdowns from it for the purpose of financing the UNFPA share of construction costs of common premises under the auspices of the Joint Consultative Group on Policy. In line with this decision, \$2.5 million was transferred from unspent resources to this reserve in 1992.

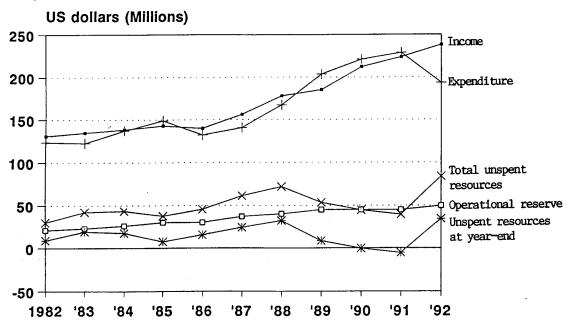

At its thirty-eighth session, the Governing Council in decision 91/36 decided that the level of the operational reserve should be set at 20 per cent of regular resources income for each year of the UNFPA work plan, and that the level of the reserve would be reviewed every other year. As a result, during 1992 the level of the operational reserve was increased by \$3.0 million. A reserve for field office accommodation amounting to \$5.0 million was approved by the Governing Council for 1992-1993 (decision 91/36, para. 17). In accordance with this decision, \$2.5 million was transferred from general resources to this reserve in 1992.

For UNFPA, TSS costs were \$1.9 million and AOS \$2.4 million. The entire \$1.0 million paid as support costs to NGOs were in respect of AOS costs.
