Report of the Administrator

SUMMARY

Summary financial information on all trust funds established by the Administrator since 1981.

I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. Regulation 5.1 of the Financial Regulations of the United Nations
 Development Programme (UNDP), adopted by the Governing Council in its decision
 81/28 of 30 June 1981, gives the Administrator the authority to establish trust
 funds for specified purposes consistent with the policies, aims and activities
 of UNDP.
- 2. Each year a detailed report is submitted to the Governing Council of all trust funds established by the Administrator during the previous calendar year. The report provides a brief narrative for each fund, covering its purpose and scope, and a table indicating donors, recipients, expected duration, and executing agencies as well as the amount of contribution and the arrangements for support costs. Document DP/1993/44/Add.3 covers the trust funds established by the Administrator in 1992.
- 3. The present report provides summary financial information on the trust funds established by the Administrator since 1981 as requested by the Governing Council in its decision 89/60 of 30 June 1989.

II. TRUST FUNDS AND SUB-TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED BY THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

4. From the initial three funds established in 1982, the programme has expanded rapidly to cover 75 trust funds and sub-trust funds in operation by the end of 1992. Programme delivery has increased from \$326,968 in 1982 to \$42,668,832 in 1992. This growth is summarized as follows:

5. Section A of the annex to the present report provides a summary of the income and expenditure of the individual trust funds and sub-trust funds, together with the balance of unexpended resources at 31 December 1992.

III. SUB-TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED BY UNDP ON BEHALF OF TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

A. United Nations Capital Development Fund

6. At the end of 1992, there were eight sub-trust funds in operation under the United Nations Capital Development Fund (UNCDF). Total income received to 1992 in respect of these sub-trust funds amounts to \$11,700,022 and expenditure to \$6,599,838, leaving an unexpended balance of \$5,100,184 at 31 December 1992.

B. <u>United Nations Revolving Fund for Natural</u> Resources Exploration

7. At the end of 1992, there were two sub-trust funds in operation under the United Nations Revolving Fund for Natural Resources Exploration (UNRFNRE). Total income received to 1992 in respect of these sub-trust funds amounted to \$200,549 and expenditure to \$127,709, leaving an unexpended balance of \$72,840 at 31 December 1992.

C. United Nations Fund for Sudano-Sahelian Activities

8. At the end of 1992, there were 17 sub-trust funds in operation under the United Nations Sudano-Sahelian Activities (UNSO). Total income received to 1992 in respect of these sub-trust funds amounted to \$32,672,833 and expenditure to \$32,194,024, leaving an unexpended balance of \$478,809 at 31 December 1992.

D. United Nations Volunteers Programme

9. At the end of 1992, there were 31 sub-trust funds in operation under the United Nations Volunteers Programme (UNV). Total income received to 1992 in respect of these sub-trust funds amounted to \$17,607,754 and expenditure to \$10,871,793, leaving an unexpended balance of \$6,735,961 at 31 December 1992.

E. <u>United Nations Fund for Science and Technology</u> <u>for Development</u>

10. At the end of 1992, there were 12 sub-trust funds in operation under the United Nations Fund for Science and Technology for Development (UNFSTD). Total income received to 1992 in respect of these sub-trust funds amounted to \$30,704,733 and expenditure to \$28,829,604, leaving an unexpended balance of \$1,875,129 at 31 December 1992.

F. United Nations Development Fund for Women

11. At the end of 1992, there were five sub-trust funds in operation under the United Nations Development Fund for Women (UNIFEM). Total income received to 1992 in respect of these sub-trust funds amounted to \$6,036,374 and expenditure to \$3,506,495, leaving an unexpended balance of \$2,529,879 at 31 December 1992.
