APPROVAL AUTHORITY

Request for authority to approve assistance to projects
of the Government of Swaziland

Note by the Administrator

1. The second country programme for Swaziland ended on 31 December 1981. The Administrator has been informed by the Government that due to circumstances beyond its control it is unable to submit its third country programme to the Governing Council for consideration and approval until June 1983. Consequently, in accordance with the revised country programming procedures for the third cycle, 1982-1986, as contained in document DP/518 and endorsed by the Council in its decision 81/15, the Administrator is hereby requesting authority to approve assistance to projects which are submitted by the Government in the interim.
 2. Should the Council grant such authority to the Administrator, he will proceed with appraisal and approval action on requests for UNDP assistance to projects in accordance with the decisions of the Governing Council that expenditures be kept in reasonable conformity with the relevant indicative planning figure (IPF) and always subject to the over-riding requirement of containing expenditures within the financial resources available at any given time, so as to preserve the financial integrity of the Programme.
