In Bermuda, UNDP-supported activities were carried out within the framework of the former country programme for the Caribbean which was financed under the undistributed indicative planning figure (IPF) for the Caribbean. However, consequent on decision 80/30 of the Governing Council at its twenty-seventh session to allocate separate IPFs during the third cycle for Bermuda and the other countries and territories formerly included under the undistributed IPF, the programme terminated on 31st December 1981.

UNDP and the Government of Bermuda have accordingly begun the process of identifying the elements of a new country programme for Bermuda for the period 1982-1986. Some activities have been tentatively identified but are in need of further elaboration, which will be done during the course of the year. Projects, when formulated, will be approved by the Administrator where they are within the ambit of the priorities identified by the Government in the country programme document.
