### INTRODUCTION

1. The third country programme for Hungary for the third UNDP programming cycle, 1982-1986, has been prepared by the Hungarian UNDP project jury headed by the Deputy President of the National Commission on Technological Development of the Government and composed of representatives of major ministries and national commissions for international organizations. The exercise was conducted in close co-operation with the UNDP European Office. The country programme is oriented towards meeting national priority needs. At the same time, in line with its constant policy of enhancing economic and technical co-operation with the developing countries, the Government of Hungary is ready to make available to these countries the practical experience obtained in the implementation of the projects included in the country programme by providing facilities for training their specialists in Hungary and by offering

# E. Transportation

- 16. National activities in support of the UNDP regional project, Trans-European Motorway (RER/80/012), were begun in Hungary under (HUN/77/001) in 1978, for which an allocation of US\$455,000 was made. These activities included traffic studies, development of preliminary and final designs and a location study, all leading to the modernization for motorway design and construction. A supplementary allocation is now requested for continued modernization of access roads and computerized traffic control. The additional Government contribution will be Ft.270 million (US\$7,715,000) and UNDP is requested to contribute US\$80,000.
- 17. In addition to the Trans-European Motorway project, Hungary participates in four ongoing regional projects: Use of Computers for Statistical Purposes (RER/78/008), Building Construction under Seismic Conditions in the Balkan Region (RER/79/015), European Co-operation on Environmental Health Aspects of Control of Chemicals (RER/79/016), and the European Co-operative Programme for Conservation and Exchange of Crop Genetic Resources (RER/80/005).
