PREPARATIONS FOR THE THIRD CYCLE, 1982-1986

Over-all planning for UNDP resources, including Indicative Planning Figures (IPFs) for developing countries for 1982-1986

The note by the Administrator on this item (DP/425) indicated that supplementary information on 1982-1986 country and regional IPFs would be provided to the Special Meeting in a conference room paper. This paper contains the indicated information and other material.

- (a) Tables 1 and 2 in this paper are designed to facilitate comparison between the summary results of country IPF calculations based on the various proposals for 1982-1986 mentioned at the twenty-sixth session (see DP/425, tables 4 and 5), and the related "further calculations" submitted by the Administrator to the Special Meeting (see DP/425, tables 7 and 8). Tables 1 and 2 in this paper are alternative versions of DP/425, tables 4 and 5 in that they employ 1978 basic data on population and per capita GNP, and a total country IPF resource level of \$3,935 million, i.e. the same approach as that used in DP/425, tables 7 and 8.
- (b) Table 3 in this paper presents the individual country IPF calculations for 1982-1986 which underlie some of the illustrative approaches that are summarized in tables 1 and 2 of this paper, and in tables 7 and 8 of DP/425. The first set of individual country IPF calculations for 1982-1986 are based on the CRP/30 approach (see column 4). The second and third sets of individual country IPFs refer to two of the six "further calculations" shown in tables 7 and 8 of DP/425. These assume that 77 per cent, and 79 per cent, respectively, of the total resources available for country IPFs (employing the 14 per cent contributions approach) would be allocated to countries with per capita GNP below \$500 (see columns 5 and 6). The presentation of these three selected calculations, rather than of others, is for illustrative purposes only and does not imply any recommendation. All calculations are based on 1978 economic data. (In this table, the "CRP/30" country IPFs are calculated on the basis

of 1978 basic data, rather than 1976 data referred to in CRP/30, so as to facilitate comparison with the "77 per cent" and "79 per cent" IPFs which also use 1978 basic data.) As stated in DP/425, the World Bank Atlas does not publish 1978 per capita GNP data for a number of countries. Arbitrary estimates of per capita GNP for these countries were employed to calculate their illustrative IPFs. These estimated IPFs are combined and shown in table 3 under "other".

- (c) Table 4 in this paper presents country IPFs related to the CRP/30 proposal, but calculated on the basis of 1976 data on the population and per capita GNP of individual countries. Country results are classified under a number of income categories as specified in CRP/30. The summary of these country results is contained in DP/425, table 6.
- (d) Table 5 in this paper contains some provisional illustrative calculations of regional IPFs for 1982-1986. As indicated in DP/425 table 1, under the assumptions made, including of a 14 per cent growth rate of contributions to UNDP, the aggregate resources available for regional IPF activities for allocation among the five UNDP regional groupings is \$671.5 million. In section A of table 5 in this paper, third cycle allocations from this aggregate are suggested using the methodology employed for the second cycle (see DP/59 and the decision of the Council at its eighteenth session) and up-to-date basic data. The calculations in section B differ only in that they assume a floor value of 1.2, instead of 1.0 as used in section A.

Those calculations were made in the context of two assumptions made in the documentation before the twenty-sixth session (DP/377), i.e. use of roughly estimated 1978-1979 basic data, and a resource total of \$3,827.2 million. The present calculations employ alternative assumptions, as used in DP/425, tables 7 and 8, i.e. 1978 basic data and a resource total of \$3,935.5 million. In this and other tables in this paper, data do not always add to totals because of rounding.

a/ The provisional illustrative third cycle calculations in section A are based on up-to-date data and the same criteria and methodology as determined by the Council for the calculation of individual regional IPFs for the current cycle, 1977-1981 (see DP/59 and E/5543/Rev.1, paragraph 47).

This current approach calls for 85 per cent of the total resources available to be shared among individual regions on the basis of their aggregate country IPFs; and 15 per cent to be shared according to six selected regional supplementary criteria, with each of these criteria valued according to the "square of the rank" (see DP/59). The resulting IPPs are to be modified to ensure that no region has a negative change in the value of its regional IPF compared with the previous cycle; and that the modified figures for all regions are to be further increased by a factor of 1.025.

Six sets of calculations of regional IPFs are shown in section A, corresponding to the six alternative "further calculations" of country IPFs in table 7 of DP/425, i.e. that 71, 73, 75, 77, 79 and 81 per cent, respectively, of the total available for country IPFs should go to countries with 1978 per capita GNP below \$500. The regional supplementary criteria used in the calculation of regional IPFs consider the number of least developed countries in the region (double weight); the number of least developed countries in the region; the population per physician in the region; the literacy rate of the adult population in the region; and the share of industry in the GNP of the region. The measurement of these criteria for use in this table was made on the basis of latest available data.

Since the above calculations produced third cycle regional IPPs greater than corresponding second cycle IPFs, the floor criterion (of no negative change between one cycle and the next) was non-operative except in one case to a very minor degree. This exceptional case required an upward modification of the Latin American IPF for 1982-1986 of \$0.4 million under the "81 per cent" calculation.

b/ The calculations in section B differ from those above in only one respect, i.e. they assume that in no case should third cycle regional IPFs be less than 1.2 times the corresponding second cycle regional IPF (before the 2.5 per cent final increase indicated above). This assumption serves to increase the regional IPF of the Latin American region above the results using the approach only of 85 per cent according to aggregate country IPFs and 15 per cent according to regional supplementary criteria. The increases due to the application of this floor assumption are as follows (in million dollars): 0, using the "71 per cent" and "73 per cent" formulae; \$0.3 million ("75 per cent"); \$5.7 million ("77 per cent");\$10.2 million ("79 per cent"); and \$14.3 million ("81 per cent").
