Extract from the New Delhi Declaration and Plan of Action, Third General Conference of UNIDO, New Delhi, India, 21 January - 8 February 1980

1. UNIDO III, at its concluding session on Saturday 9 February 1980, approved the New Delhi Declaration and Plan of Action by roll call vote with 83 votes in favour, 22 votes against and one abstention. The draft text submitted by the Group of 77 was approved by the Havana Meeting of Ministers of Industry. The Plan of Action in Section IX, Institutional Arrangements for UNIDO, specifically refers to the programme of Special Industrial Services and the Senior Industrial Development Field Advisers as follows:

Urges UNDP to:

Implement the United Nations General Assembly resolution adopted by the thirty-third session by doubling the annual level of financial resources available to UNIDO's Special Industrial Services Programme.

Hold consultation with UNIDO with a view to reaching a suitable arrangement for facilitating the financing of technical assistance activities in the developing countries in the industrial field.

Strengthen the SIDFA programme and its effectiveness, increase their number and assure greater recruitment of SIDFAs from developing countries, and ensure the necessary financing as decided by the IDB and approved by the United Nations General Assembly.
