## Introduction

1. The tables which follow include a summary of statistics on technical co-operation project activities of the organizational entities of the United Nations and detailed information on the United Nations Department of Technical Co-operation for Development (DTCD). This information was requested in Governing Council decision 79/22, and this report has been prepared in conjunction with two other reports before the thirty-third session of the Council, DP/1986/11/Add.3 and DP/1986/68, which contain basic programme data related to work financed by UNDP and information on agency regular budget and non-UNDP extrabudgetary technical co-operation activities. An analysis of the DTCD programme delivery and administrative costs is included in DP/1986/48.
2. Financial data in this document have been derived from the financial statements for the year ending 31 December 1985.

## PROGRAMME DELIVERY

3. In 1985, the organizational entities of the United Nations delivered a technical co-operation programme of \$273 million, compared to \$254 million in 1984. This represents a 7.5 per cent increase in project expenditures.
4. Of this amount, DTCD executed a programme of \$127.2 million. Of this total, the Department expended \$87.9 million for UNDP-financed projects, \$13.7 million for projects financed by the United Nations Fund for Population Activities (UNFPA), \$18 million for Trust Fund-financed activities and \$7.5 million under the United Nations Regular Programme for Technical Co-operation. In comparison with 1984, budgets increased by 18 per cent in 1985 to \$165 million and the above-mentioned delivery of \$127.2 million was 15 per cent above the previous year's total of \$110.8 million. The implementation rate was 77 per cent.
5. On a geographic basis, the DTCD-executed programme in 1985 included expenditures of \$45.2 million in Africa; \$36.1 million in Asia and the Pacific; \$28.6 million in the Middle East, Mediterranean, Europe and Interregional (MEMEI); and \$17.3 million in the Americas. The largest growth was in Asia, where the programme increased by \$7.5 million. Project delivery in Africa remained the largest, but its share of the total delivery declined from 38 to 36 per cent.
6. The distribution of project expenditures by substantive sectors was the following: natural resources and energy, \$59.7 million; development planning, \$21.7 million; statistics, \$17.7 million; public administration, \$11.8 million; population, \$7.1 million; social development, \$4.8 million; United Nations Educational and Training Programme for Southern Africa (UNETPSA), \$3.2 million; and others, \$1.2 million. Natural resources and energy, which comprised 47 per cent of the DTCD total, remained the largest programme; development planning continued to be the second largest. The largest growth by sector was in statistics, which increased by \$5.4 million (43 per cent) over the previous year's expenditures.
7. On a component basis, Department delivery in 1985 included \$59.5 million for project personnel, \$34.8 million for equipment, \$21.5 million for training, \$7.2 million for sub-contracted services and \$4.2 million for miscellaneous. The component which showed the largest growth was equipment, which rose by \$11.1 million. The proportion of total expenditures for sub-contracts, training and miscellaneous remained steady and that of project personnel declined to 47 per cent from 52 per cent in 1984.
