OPENING OF THE SESSION AND ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

<u>Provisional agenda and organization of work of the resumed</u> <u>thirty-eighth session, including the Standing Committee</u> <u>for Programme Matters</u>

Note by the secretariat

1. At its thirty-eighth session, by its decision 91/52 of 25 June 1991, the Governing Council of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) decided that the thirty-eighth session of the Council, including the Standing Committee for Programme Matters, should be resumed in New York in September 1991 for a period of three days. The provisional agenda for the resumed session is contained in annex I, the provisional agenda for the Standing Committee for Programme Matters is contained in annex II and the tentative schedule of work for the resumed session, including that of the Standing Committee, is contained in annex III.

2. As already informally agreed, the Governing Council may wish to allocate the main agenda item, i.e., Special Programme Resources, to the Standing Committee for Programme Matters for its consideration and recommendations to the Council.

STANDING COMMITTEE FOR PROGRAMME MATTERS

3. In paragraph 3 of its decision 91/2 A of 22 February 1991, the Governing Council decided that the meetings of the Standing Committee for Programme Matters should be chaired by the President of the Governing Council or by another member of the Bureau designated by the President. The Chairman may also be designated as Rapporteur of the Standing Committee.

4. The Standing Committee for Programme Matters will elaborate and finalize draft decisions on those items referred to it by the Governing Council for the adoption of such decisions by the Council itself.

5. Annex III, which contains, <u>inter alia</u>, the tentative schedule of work of the Standing Committee for Programme Matters, should be considered provisional and indicative in nature so that the Committee may be in a position to take up items on a more flexible basis. In particular, should it complete consideration of an item before the date indicated, it would move immediately to the next item on its work schedule.
